### **APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE – GRANT APPLICATION**

#### REPORT OF THE TOWN CLERK

#### 1. Pendeen Friends of the School Association

- 1.1 The Town Council has received a request for grant funding from the Pendeen Friends of the School Association (FSA) in respect of a project for a community library for young people and their families in the Pendeen area.
- 1.2 The library will provide fiction and non-fiction books for parents to share with their children via an electronic system replacing the old ticketing method which is now obsolete.
- 1.3 The proposal has the support of the County Library Service which has suggested that a system called "The Junior Librarian" is established which enables up to 10,000 books to be entered on to a hand held scanner. A computer will be required to run this new system. The cost of "The Junior Librarian" system is £1,195.00. The cost of the computer system is £500.00. The scheme will be run on a weekly basis by two volunteer librarians from the village.
- 1.4 The project will benefit approximately 120 families in the area, improve reading skills and improve a child's ability to become literate and articulate. The FSA is non profit making and is committed to equal opportunities.
- 1.5 The FSA has held a number of fundraising activities and requests for financial assistance have also made to Boscaswell Stores and The Foyle Foundation.
- 1.6 Accounts have been provided which show income of £4,976.82 and expenditure of £3,736.94, a balance of £1239.88 as at 10 October 2011.
- 1.7 The FSA has requested a grant of £600.00.
- 1.8 The Town Council has made the following previous financial contributions:-
  - Dec 2010 £1,000.00
  - Oct 2007 £300.00
  - Feb 2007 £800.00
  - Mar 2006 £1,000.00
  - Mar 2005 £600.00

# 2. Remaining Budget Provision in 2012 / 2103

- 2.1 There is currently £20,000 in the 2012 / 2013 budget for grant applications.
- 3. The Town Council's instructions are sought.
