9. <u>Proposal to Empower Town and Parish Councils</u>

You will recall that last year that the Town Council gave its support to a proposal by Leiston-cum-Sizewell Town Council and the Suffolk Association of Local Councils to the Communities and Local Government Minister under the Sustainable Communities Act.

The proposal called for guidance that, in the case of LARGE planning applications containing numerous technical or consultants' reports, developers should be exhorted to:-

- (a) Attend a Local Council Meeting (or a Town and Parish Meeting) to answer questions on the application; and
- (b) Provide some funding to help the Local Council make an independent assessment of the application

to enable local councils to make proper comments on the application and so do their job properly.

Discussions have continued with DCLG officials and with the Minister, Greg Clark. It is believed that a decision is near and Town and Parish Councils are being asked for additional help in one or two ways:

- 1. By writing to or emailing Greg Clark (gregclarkmp@parliament.uk or Rt Hon Greg Clark MP, House of Commons, London SW1A 0AA) urging him to support the proposal and act on it accordingly; and
- 2. By writing to or emailing your own MP asking him/her to write to Greg Clark urging him to support it.
