**REPORT OF THE TOWN CLERK**

1. The Town Council has received a letter from the Cornwall Air Ambulance regarding a request for a donation to help support the work of the Trust. 2010 continues to be another busy year and the cost of keeping the Cornwall Air Ambulance flying and serving the community is expected to rise to between £25,000 and £30,000 per week. This figure is largely dependent on the number of emergencies flown. The trust is also hoping to replace some its life saving equipment and monitors and would welcome any contribution towards its emergency equipment fund. So far this year, the total amount of grant given by town and parish council is £1,490.
