## REPORT OF THE TOWN CLERK

- 1. The Town Council has received a letter from the St Just Community Association regarding a request for financial assistance towards the development of a new website.
- 2. The Association has been working hard to obtain financial support to upgrade the building and its facilities and was recently successful in securing £400.00 from Councillor Chris Goninan towards much needed computer equipment.
- 3. The estimated cost of the new website is £1,600.00.

- 5. No previous grants have been awarded.
