NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

for the St Just Neighbourhood Plan

1. A Referendum will be held on **Thursday, 13th January 2022** to decide the question:

“Do you want Cornwall Council to use the neighbourhood plan for St Just to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. Applications to register to vote or to vote by post or proxy should be made to the Electoral Registration Officer at 3rd Floor, South Wing, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro, TR1 3AY based on the deadlines set out below:

New applications to register to vote. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote	12 midnight on Wednesday, 22 December 2021
New applications to vote by post or to cancel or amend an existing postal/proxy vote	5 pm on Thursday, 23rd December 2021
New applications to vote by proxy	5 pm on Wednesday, 5th January 2022
Applications for an emergency proxy vote (in cases where unforeseen illness, incapacity, occupation, service or employment occurs after the deadline for proxy applications). The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 5th January 2022. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 5th January 2022.	5 pm on Thursday, 13th January 2022
