A simpler version: I value the wildlife (plants, insects, animals etc...) of the area.

Car Parking/Traffic: check out if there are any accident statistics for the area.

Update: Vanessa Lockwood said at a recent CEG meeting that mapping of developments should be included in the plan. This is therefore to be the focus of our next meeting – Jim has been working on this and would be needed at the meeting (check if he can do this). He and Richard are meeting anyway to discuss the building characteristics topic. Dot to get big map from Jess, if possible.
