## 2. Minutes from previous meeting.

#### 3. Matters arising.

Sustainable NDP –David O-B has read again – looks useful but may be limited in this area:

- Advice can be provided, but people in this group and around the area possibly already have this knowledge.
- May not have continuing grants available.
- Is this a question for SG as this also applies to the other groups?.
- May also be already applied through current planning regulations.

**ACTION**: David O-B will call and investigate further. He will then communicate with Judith S and assess. Feedback to next meeting.

## 4. Report and feedback from Sarah Furley meeting with SG.

Most people were present at the meeting, and both Judith and Dot had sent through report papers. Discussion points raised:

- Stakeholder consultation by SG with possible landowners this will come much later as this may influence the options/decisions too early.
- NDP needs to be developmental.
- No housing target because of AONB etc... but we would have a target if we were not. However, we do have people on the housing register for this area.

- Rural exception sites. Can apply for planning but must be 100% affordable – can be negotiated down to 50%. Needs evidence of local need. We need to have identified those areas.
- Affordable housing allows for local people to get 1<sup>st</sup> choice, but if these are not taken up then others get the option. There is a criteria to get on the register.

**ACTION:** Judith will send the criteria. Dot send on to BEG.

- Sarah Furley topics sheet. We deal with column 1 add topic with more detail. Use our original topic list taking account of main concerns as on "Dot's matrix".
- Where does the questionnaire fit in? When options emerge then we need the evidence gathered SF will tell us this, but we will then need to find that evidence.

NHEG have indicated a possibility of merging, but it was felt to be not most useful course of action at this time. Joint meetings on joint topics would be a good idea.

## 5. Discussion on next steps and matrix.

- Suggestion that we should use the experience and expertise of people on the group and break up into smaller groups to deal with specific actions. It was felt this was a good idea.
- Next step is to add results of Have Your Say into the topics column 1 of SF, and some bits into options column 3.

**ACTION:** Judith send out collation of all points of minutes to date. JM, DS, KP & RG. Thursday 18.10.18 At RG office 7pm. DS circulate results of this ASAP.

- How to address housing need for people requiring no stairs, or need for rental properties.
- 1 questionnaire but could be lots of consultations on the way e.g. focus groups about different topics.
