Following consideration it was agreed that the draft action plan would be progressed to the 15 May meeting for adoption and that the council would also agree a structure to progress actions.

Cornwall Councillor report

Cllr Brian Clemens had provided a written report to the Council as he was joining the meeting part way through, which focussed on the following areas:-

- i. achieving free school transport for a young girl with learning difficulties previously denied transport at a previous meeting.
- ii. talks with planning officers to try and negotiate a resolution to approve two applications that the Town Council supported but were up for refusal, both have now been passed.
- iii. breaches of planning that are being dealt with and are at various stages of the enforcement process.
- iv. the Network Panel meeting (16 March 2023) will be the final meeting of the panel as it moves to the newly formed CAPS in May 2023.
- v. a drop in surgery with myself, the Tri Officer and PCSO had a volunteer come forward to act as coordinator for a speed watch team to once again be set up for this area and PCSO Andrew Tonkin has launched a request for volunteers on Facebook and would appreciate the Town Council and councillors also putting out a call on social media, and
- vi. An overview committee had reviewed the provision of Fire Fighting in Cornwall, the outcome being that a 24 hour provision of call answering would continue to be provided at Tolvaddon.

TC.215 Toilet Maintenance and repair St. Just and Pendeen

Following the council's acquisition of the toilets at St. Just and Pendeen it was necessary to identify a firm as a preferred supplier for repairs and regular maintenance. The Town Council had approached 3 contractors for quotes. One contractor presented a quote the other two did not; one declining to quote. Following discussion it was unanimously

RESOLVED The Town Council accepts the quote and will commission the work subject to some minor conditions.

TC.216 Plain an Gwarry works

Following the Town Council taking responsibility for the site a programme of works was agreed between the Town Council and Historic England under a Scheduled Monument Consent (SMC) to undertake necessary repairs to the Plain and to install small areas of granite surfacing at its entrances where the ground surface had become eroded through extensive footfall. In addition to this it was also agreed to do some remedial drainage works to the heavily trafficked 'desire line' route between the northern and southern entrances to the monument.

Recently the specialist contractor asked to provide a quote for the work suggested making a small variation to the specification following a site visit. This variation was approved by English Heritage and members were now asked to consider the quote. Following discussion it was unanimously

RESOLVED The Town Council accepts the quote and commissions the work.
