S.137 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972 - APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

REPORT OF THE TOWN CLERK

1. The Town Council has received a letter from the St Just Women's Institute requesting financial assistance towards the renovation of the entrance hall which is in need of redecoration. The hall is used by a number of local groups and organisations such as U3A and the Lafrowda Committee and it is the income from these groups that is used to maintain the hall.
2. It is anticipated that the cost of the works will be in the region of the £750.00, although any additional funds could be used for other necessary repairs and redecoration of the building.
3. The Town Council has made no previous grants to the St Just Women's Institute.
4. A copy of the latest accounts has also been submitted with the application.
5. The Council's instructions on each of the requests are sought.
