REPORT OF THE TOWN CLERK

1. The Town Council has received a letter from the St Just Community Association regarding a request for financial assistance towards the development of a new website.
2. The Association has been working hard to obtain financial support to upgrade the building and its facilities and was recently successful in securing £400.00 from Councillor Chris Goninan towards much needed computer equipment.
3. The estimated cost of the new website is £1,600.00.
4. In accordance with the approved criteria and in the absence of audited accounts, the Association has provided copies of its most recent bank accounts to support its application.
5. No previous grants have been awarded.
6. The Town Council has also received a request for financial assistance from the Pendeen School FSA towards meeting the cost of a school trip to Isle de Batz as part of an education exchange with Huelgoat, Brittany with whom we are twinned.
7. A copy of the recent accounts have been supplied
8. Previous grants are as follows:

 - March 2006 £1000
 - January 2005 £600
