REPORT OF THE TOWN CLERK

- 1. In 2008 the Town Council approved a three year financial commitment to a number of local organisations under Section 137 and Section 145 of the Local Government Act 1972 and the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.
- That commitment has now come to an end and the purpose of this report is to seek
 the Town Council's endorsement of its decision to include financial provision for
 these organisations in its 2011 / 2012 budget, and to consider making a further
 financial commitment in the light of information on how each of these organisations is
 currently operating.
- 3. The local organisations which have been the subject of the Town Council's financial support over the preceding three years, and the sum that each has been granted is set out below:-

•	St Just Community Sports Association	£2,500.00 (LGA (Misc Prov) 1976
•	Lafrowda Festival	£2,000.00 (S.145) LGA 1972
•	Centre for Pendeen	£1,000.00 (S.137) LGA 1972
•	Pendeen Parish Rooms	£1,000.00 (S.137) LGA 1972
•	Nancherrow Centre	£1,000.00 (S.137) LGA 1972

- 4. Town Councillors who are the Council's representative on these bodies will be asked to provide an update on the organisation and to present their most recent audited accounts.
- 5. Financial provision within the current year's budget is based on the same allocations as set out above
